This year, the Guild Executive has been focused on building upon the strategy developed in 2014 with the purpose of being 'The Champion of New Zealand's Proud and Innovative Beer Industry'. Members of the Executive have been actively working through the top nine challenges identified in the strategy, namely to:

- 1. Become the recognised voice for the NZ beer industry
- 2. Increase membership and member engagement
- 3. Make the beer awards a premium NZ event
- 4. Create and implement an education strategy for the industry
- 5. Support an export strategy for the NZ beer industry
- 6. Define a robust governance structure with clear roles and responsibilities
- 7. Develop and implement PR strategy around 'the positive beer story
- 8. Ensure sustainable resourcing of and for the Guild
- 9. Better align with the entire beer industry value chain

I thank them for their commitment in attending to these challenges. The key tenet behind all their work is that we are a membership organisation and we need to deliver on representing our members, providing them with value and content that they can use both personally and within their respective businesses.

In addition, work is underway to ensure the Guild is seen as a key representative of the brewing/beer industry and is a body to seek out as a voice for beer. Blackland PR is a key partner for the Guild and is enabling the Guild to be seen and heard as a credible voice for brewing and beer. I thank the Blackland team for their tireless effort on the Guild's behalf and personally to John Mitchell of Blackland PR for his wise counsel when sought out for comment.

It is great to see members growing and flourishing as we continue to see many challenges facing the sector, notably the ever-changing legislative environment in which members operate. These include but are not limited to:



- Health and Safety
- Food Labelling
- Food Safety
- Advertising Standards
- Alcohol Licensing
- Customs and Excise
- Identifying barriers to trade

The Guild is engaging with policy and decision makers to ensure the views of members and the sector are heard. The Executive continues working to ensure the Guild can provide the information and tools to ensure members have the knowledge to ensure continuing compliance with the ever-changing environment.

The Brewers' Guild - Another Year:

It is hard to believe that another year has almost passed for the Brewers' Guild. It doesn't seem that long ago that we were in Wellington celebrating Townshend Brewery's NZ Champion Brewery achievement, together with all the other trophy and medal winners, and the inaugural awarding of Brewers' Guild Honours.

It was great to see this initiative received with such enthusiasm both from the surprised recipients and all those that are part of brewing in New Zealand. All worthy of the recognition of the industry and their peers with Richard Emerson and David Cryer becoming Honorary Fellows, Tracy Banner an Honorary Member, Martin Bennett and Ted & Frances Verrity as Life Members, Geoff Griggs for Industry Achievement Award and Te Radar the Presidential Award. I look forward to seeing new Honours being awarded into the future.

I reflect on Ralph Bungard's words form last year, 'the Brewers' Guild of New Zealand has been the representative body of New Zealand brewers. In that time, the Guild has largely been driven by a few passionate and hardworking individuals who have been willing to donate time from their "day job" to form and grow the successful organisation that is our Guild. The initial members had vision and passion and they must be proud of their achievements.' These words continue to ring true as the Guild continues to grow and evolve a pace with the growing and evolving brewing sector.

This year the Guild Executive has put its energy and resources into developing and implementing the Top 9 Challenges of the Strategy agreed at last year's AGM. I am pleased to be able to report good progress has been made, but acknowledge there is still work to be done and am confident that those appointed to the Executive will continue to build on this work.



1. Become the recognised voice for the NZ beer industry

We have also been active making submissions on member's behalf to ensure our voice is being held in both local and central government, with Jenny and Emma both taking a leading role in this area.

Submissions in the following areas have been made:

- Health and Safety
- Food Labelling
- Food Safety
- Advertising Standards
- Alcohol Licensing
- Customs and excise
- Australian small brewer refund scheme conflict with CER

Members of the Executive have represented the Guild in meetings and forums with governmental officials when appropriate. With the relationships started and developed in these places ensure dialogue continues long after.

2. Increase membership and member engagement

This has been the main focus for the Guild Executive, want to engage with the membership and ensure members are receiving value from their membership. With Matt Stevens driving this Challenge, a number of seminars were held in Christchurch, Wellington and Auckland which provided members with industry specific knowledge around sensory analysis and Food Safety, as well as an opportunity to interact on a more social basis with peers.

We have also built on the seminars held prior to last year's awards and continue to look at ways to bring timely and industry specific education to members. These have been very successful with very positive feedback from the membership, and will be continued, with a particular focus on Health & Safety, Exporting and Business growth evident at this year's Conference.

3. Making the beer awards a premium NZ event

The Guild has taken the bold step to bring the awards to Auckland this year. Plenty of work has gone on to ensure this is New Zealand's premier beer event of the year, and the Guild has yet again seen a record increase in awards entries, from 670 in 2014 to 858 this year, with the trophy winners and medallists to be announced in style at the SkyCity gala dinner, 19 September 2015.

In addition to the work done by the Guild Executive, Craig Bowen and more notably our Executive Officer, Phillippa Boa, this is looking on track to be recognised as the 'Event' and BlacklandPR has been very successful in gaining significant new media interest across television, print and radio.



4. Create and implement an education strategy for the industry

The Exec decided to focus on internal technical brewing or brewery related education activities this year in order to add value to members in line with Challenge 2 above, driven by Matt Stevens with support from the rest of the Executive team. This year's annual Awards Week conference marks another step forward in programming with input from a range of industry experts across a range of topics to provide "a focus on growth: tools and insights for taking your business forward".

We did not have the resources to focus on external or consumer-based education, but hope to pick that up again in the future.

5. Support an export strategy for the NZ beer industry

The Guild's links to New Zealand Trade and Enterprise (NZTE) remain strong and we continue to work with them to assist members with their export strategies, creating capability and capacity for our New Zealand brewers to take their amazing beers to the world.

Alan has taken a leading role in this area, working to ensure the development of lasting and beneficial relationships to support the export initiative, and is in talks with NZTE to provide a Path to Market export workshop in the coming year.

The Guild was also proud to support O-I in the development of a craft beer bottle that captures the essence of New Zealand craft beer for the export market.

6. Define a robust governance structure with clear roles and responsibilities

With myself on the driving seat for this Challenge, an Executive Policy and Procedures Manual has been developed to ensure the Executive conduct the Guild's business in a professional and transparent manner. As the Guild continues to grow further resources will need to be given to this aspect to ensure we have the right structures looking to the future.

The Guild remains in good shape financially. Membership is growing and we continue to look at ways to expand our revenue base through partnerships.



7. Develop and implement PR strategy around 'the positive beer story'

With Jono and Jenny both playing a major role in this Challenge, Blackland PR was reappointed this year as the Guild's media consultant to assist us in getting in front of the media and for us to be sought out for comment on matters relating to brewing and beer.

It is pleasing to be asked for comment both from the media and in support of members and their successes. There has been a noticeable increase in requests for commentary and we are seeing stories on television and in print media that project brewing and beer in a more positive light, with 'good beer' story being seen and read about by the public.

8. Ensure sustainable resourcing of and for the Guild

The work of the Guild has grown throughout the year. To ensure we deliver on members' expectations and the volunteer basis of the executive it was agreed to increase the hours of our Administrator, Phillippa Boa. This has made a difference, firstly delivering more information and events to members, secondly supporting members of the Executive to ensure we remain on task while still completing day jobs.

9. Better align with the entire beer industry value chain

Emma has taken a leading role on this challenge, with contributions around MPI discussions, Health & Safety, Labelling and the Keg amnesty which so far has seen the repatriation of over 150 kegs to breweries and raised the public awareness regarding ownership.

This year's Awards Week event programme also sees the introduction of an Industry Trade Show, to increase networking amongst the brewers and the key suppliers to the industry, with the goal of further strengthening the links in the beer industry value chain.

The Guild want to ensure the full beer story is known to New Zealand. Beer from 'farm to foam' is a 2 billion dollar contribution to our economy. Celebrate this and make it known to each and every one you meet. The aim is to communicate better with the sector partners and represent a more holistic picture of the beer value chain.



AWARDS SUMMARY

This year saw another significant increase in entries to the Brewers Guild of New Zealand Beer Awards. From 670 entries last year to a record 858 entries this year. Judging was again held in Christchurch with 25 judges and 5 trainee judges assembling for 3 days to assess each beer on its merits, admirably supported by a team of Stewards, which included a group of staff and students from the Massey University Food Technology Department.

This is the 6th year the Brewers Guild has partnered with Massey University. We value this relationship immensely and wish to thank the Massey team for their dedication and enthusiasm they showed.

A total of 59 Gold Medals, 159 Silver and 243 Bronze were awarded against the following criteria:

Beer Judging Award Criteria



Gold Medal

A world class beer that accurately exemplifies the style, or may vary slightly from style parameters, while displaying the proper balance of taste, aroma and appearance.



Silver Medal

An excellent beer that may vary from style parameters while maintaining close adherence to the style and displaying excellent taste, aroma and appearance.



Bronze Medal

A fine example that may vary from style parameters and have minor deviations in taste, aroma or appearance.

This represents a figure of 53% of all entries receiving a medal. Similar to last year's figure of 52% however the number of Gold medals awarded was slightly down on last year. The increase in entries mirrors what we see in the overall New Zealand market place however I would challenge all breweries, both new and established alike, to not just make good beer but strive to make great beer. We are a small but collaborative industry and we should all be striving to give the consumer the best product possible at all times.



AWARDS SUMMARY

There were no significant changes to the judging process this year and the team of judges assembled were the most experienced group we have ever had judge these awards. At the end of the awards I asked all judges to 'champion' these awards. If you have a question or comment regarding the judging process or relating to the awards overall, please make contact with me or talk to any of the judges directly.

I would like to thank the hardworking team of judges and each and every steward for their efforts and assistance with this year's competition.

I look forward seeing even more entries at next year's awards and the bar being raised even higher. Thanks also to all 2015 sponsors for their support of these awards.
